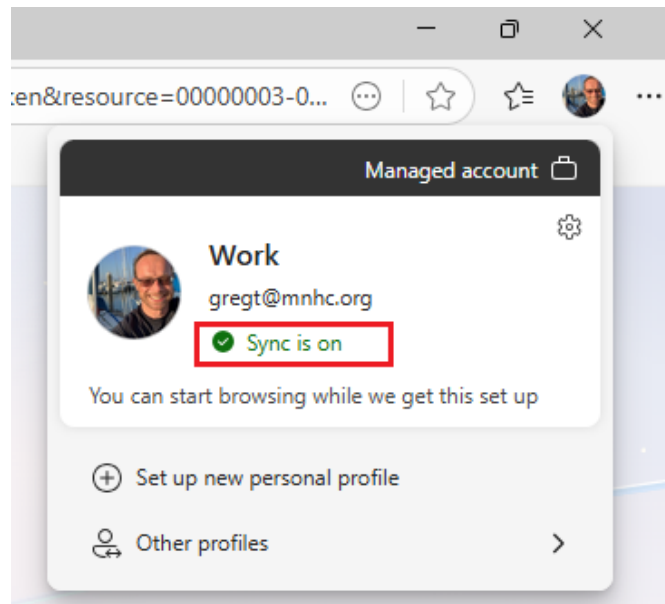
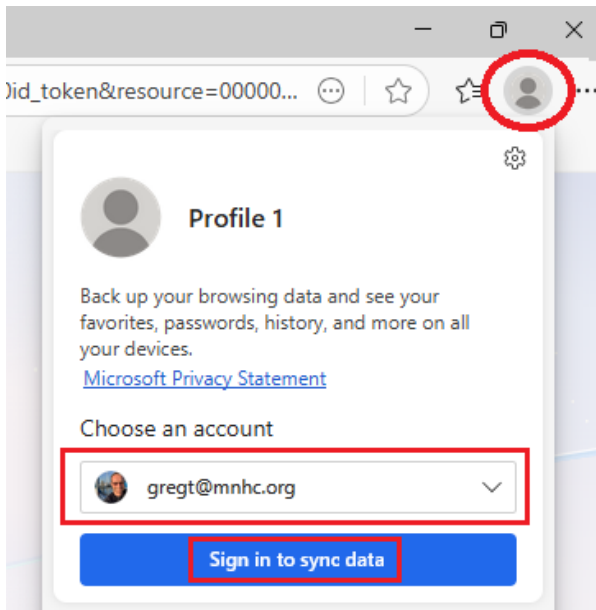


Set up and Sync Edge Favorites (AKA Bookmarks)

1. Open **Microsoft Edge**
2. Click the **profile icon** (top-right)
3. Click **Sign in**
4. Sign in with your Microsoft account
5. When prompted, choose **Turn on sync**



Your bookmarks will now sync across all devices where you sign in to Edge with this account.

To show the **Favorites bar** in **Microsoft Edge**, do the following:

Press **Ctrl + Shift + B**

If you need to turn the Favorites bar manually.

1. Go to:
 - o **Settings** → **Profiles** → **Sync**
 - o Ensure **Favorites** (bookmarks) is turned **ON**

Part 1: Export **Favorites** from Edge (HTML)

1. Open **Microsoft Edge**
2. Click the **three dots** (...) in the top-right
3. Select **Favorites**
4. Click **More options** (...) in the Favorites menu
5. Choose **Export favorites**
6. Save the file as an **HTML file** (e.g., edge_favorites.html) to a known location.

Part 2: Import Favorites into Chrome

1. Open **Google Chrome**
2. Click the **three dots** (...) in the top-right
3. Go to **Bookmarks** → **Import bookmarks and settings**
4. From the dropdown, select **Bookmarks HTML File**
5. Click **Choose File**
6. Select the exported edge_favorites.html
7. Click **Open**

Step 1: Export **Passwords** from Microsoft Edge

1. Open **Microsoft Edge**
2. Click **three dots** → **Settings**
3. Go to **Profiles**
4. Select **Passwords**
5. Next to **Saved passwords**, click **three dots**
6. Click **Export passwords**
7. Authenticate (Windows PIN / password)
8. Save the .csv file

Step 2: Import passwords into Google Chrome

If “Import” is visible (newer Chrome versions)

1. Open **Chrome**
2. Go to **Settings**
3. Select **Autofill and passwords**
4. Click **Password Manager**
5. Click **Settings** (gear icon)
6. Click **Import**
7. Select the Edge .csv file
