

Conference Room **A Left Side**

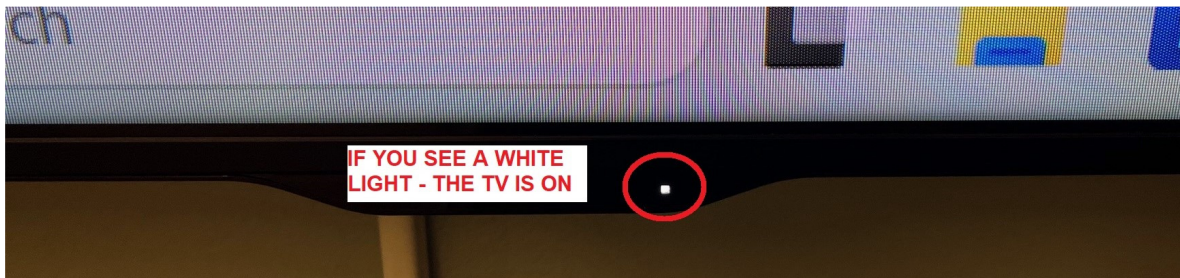
Connecting to TV - No Remote Control

1. Log in to the computer **FIRST**

Log in using your credentials before proceeding -this helps ensure the display connects properly.

2. Check TV power

- LED on = TV is ON (This is the opposite of Room B)
- LED off = Press the power button on the back left of the TV



Conference Room **B Right Side**

Connecting to TV - Remote control turns on TV

1. Log in to the computer **FIRST**

Log in using your credentials before proceeding (this helps ensure the display connects properly).

2. Check TV power

- LED On = TV is Off (This is the opposite of Room A)
- Press the power button on the remote control to Turn On



3. Check for display

Does the screen automatically appear on the TV?

- Yes → Proceed to Step 4
- No → Try the following:
 - Power off the TV, wait 10 seconds, then power it back on
 - Set the HDMI 3
 - Confirm you are logged into the computer
 - Locate the gold HDMI cable connected to the TV
 - Unplug the HDMI cable from the back of the computer, wait 10 seconds, then reconnect it firmly and check if the display appears.

Call for help if there is no image at this time.

4. Extend the display

Press Windows key + P on the keyboard

Select "Duplicate" from the menu



Alternative method:

- Right-click on the desktop → Select Display settings
- Under Multiple displays, choose Extend these displays, then click Apply

Notes:

The camera is also your microphone, so make sure it's near the person presenting.
